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2022/23 Review:

Opening Balance 1st April 2022 £16,816.44
Closing Balance 31st March 2023 £19,958.34
Average Monthly Expenditure £6,187
Average Monthly Income £6,449.

- In the year 2022/23 there was a difference of £3,141 between total expenditure and total sales.
- On analysis, our total expenditure for 2022/23 pretty much matched our total receipts. The difference of £3,141 is made up of £2,200 from past and present members and c£941 from the Ned Barney Swim.
- Since the previous year 2021/22 there has been a 12.71% increase in expenditure from the previous year and a 24.23% increase in our total receipts. The extra expenses come from pool hire and coaching costs which is to be expected in the current financial climate. Good news is we have made up for this with increased subscription revenue. Whilst we did have a small increase in subscription charges in this financial year, the extra income is mainly down to increased members and stricter procedures around our finances to ensure that all members pay their subscriptions when due.
